DEVELOP and PRESENT YOUR CASE: This course is designed to teach basic investigative analysis techniques. You will also learn to summarize case data in a clear, concise and graphical format to present it for prosecution. This course is designed for law enforcement personnel with very basic or no analytical experience who wish to learn and understand investigative analytical techniques that will enhance any investigation.

- Describe the intelligence cycle and the role of an investigator/analyst.
- Graphically depict the relationships among subjects using link analysis.
- Identify the types of data provided by various nationwide and regional databases.
- Describe the three techniques of flow charting and the appropriate use of each.
- Develop and analyze flow charts to enhance the investigation.
- Collect, decipher, analyze and chart telecommunications records.
