We will show you probably one of the best photo managers available as it makes organizing, managing and sharing photos a lot easier. This course will give you the tools to work with photos using a system known for its simplicity and ease of use.

You will learn how to efficiently manage your photo files. Key learning elements of this class include:

1. Tag your photos using keywords. This is critical - allowing you to sort and find any photo later.
2. Using Google to go to the location where the photos were taken.
3. Batch editing if you want to edit multiple photos at once.
4. Publish or export as HTML pages, for law enforcement sharing.
5. Learn how to upload your photos for selected applications.
6. Learn how to make HTML gallery pages for your use locally or you can then share them with other Officers and Attorneys.
7. Organize and burn CDS with only selected photos.
8. Make a photo black and white
9. Faster zooming
10. Full screen photo viewing
11. Turn photos into movie slideshows for court presentations
12. Resize images properly
13. Master the special effects!
14. Manage your photos in your hard drive - My Pictures folder with ease.

There are many practical applications for learning how to master Photo Management especially for officers who take photos of houses, or suspects, and need to manage those photos for future presentation to a District Attorney or for a courtroom presentation! Or you may need to know how to prepare for in-house newsletters or law enforcement based web pages
